Arabic: beginners (a)

The following is meant as an outline guide to the course. The tutor may at her/his discretion make alterations to the content and order of the course. Please ask the Course Administration Staff for guidance if you are in any doubt about the suitability of the level of the course.

Course description

The course is designed for complete beginners wishing to learn Modern Standard Arabic. At this stage, there will be much focus on structure and grammar.

What will the course cover?

- The Arabic alphabet along with vowelisation characters.
- Construction of basic phrases and sentences.
- Learning names of family members and some professions.
- Basic grammatical rules.
- Numbers 1 to 10.

Should I have experience for the course?

No. This course is designed for complete beginners starting from scratch.

What can I expect to learn?

- Introduce yourself, your family and your country.
- Learn basic greeting phrases.
- Read and write elementary Arabic.
- Learn fundamental grammatical rules required for producing new sentences & conversing in Arabic.
- Learn how to ask Yes/No questions.
- Recognise difference in gender between nouns.
- Describe things using a limited number of qualities.

What should I bring to the course?

A notebook and a pen would be very handy, be prepared to do homework.
