

Course Outline:

Digital Photography: Intermediate

The following is meant as an outline guide to the course. The tutor may at her/his discretion make alterations to the content and order of the course. Please ask the Course Administration Staff for guidance if you are in any doubt about the suitability of the level of the course.

Course description

A course designed to further your basic knowledge and skills using your digital camera and Adobe PhotoShop.

The main emphasis of the course is to practice and improve camera techniques and further your knowledge (such as framing and depth of field) and later to improve images using Adobe Photoshop.

What will the course cover?

In each lesson we will look at a variety of photos taken by other photographers, both experimental contemporary and established, looking at the quality of their photos and considering what makes them interesting. We will also look at each others selected photographs and discuss composition and content to see how they could be improved. We'll also manipulate the photos using PhotoShop in a creative way and go step by step through some of the features that PhotoShop has to offer to help get the most out of your photos.

For all those of you that have had some experience using your digital camera and PhotoShop and would like to learn more this course is ideal.

Should I have experience for the course?

Yes. This is a follow on course.

What can I expect to learn?

Students will produce one or several high quality images every week.

Additionally students will be encouraged to practice what they have learnt by taking more images during the week and will show these during the next session.

What should I bring to the course?

You will need a digital camera and, for the first week, some photos you have already taken ready to download and work from.
