The following is meant as an outline guide to the themes, language functions and grammar covered in the Stage I Russian for Beginners course. The tutor may at her/his discretion make alterations to the content and order of the course. Themes and language functions	Grammar
<b>1. Greetings</b>	Russian alphabet
<b>2. Airport</b> Spelling. Nationalities	How to compose a question Pronouns "he", "she" and "it"
<b>3. Airport</b> Writing your own name Introducing yourself	Gender of nouns
<b>4. Clearing the Customs</b> Making small conversation Luggage and possessions	Possessive pronouns "my" and "your"
<b>5. In the Street</b> Describing your location Architectural terms Cultural awareness: names in Russian	How to say "I know" and "you know" and some other verbs Imperatives such as "tell me"
<b>6. Finding your way around</b> Small dialogues with passers-by Giving directions	Using prepositions "to" and "at" "There is" in Russian Numbers 1 to 10
<b>7. Consolidating</b>	Review of the agreed most difficult topics with the students, practice and speaking.
